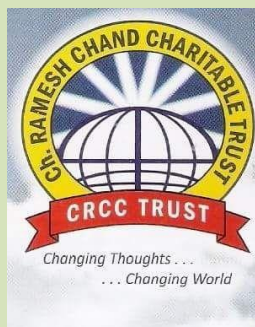

❖ Swarnjyanti Gram Swarojgar Yojna (SGSY)-2000 candidates:



SGSY has been conceived as a holistic self-governing program covering all aspects of self-employment of the rural poor peoples. We successfully completed this project. It was implemented in Uttar Pradesh & Uttarakhand. Under this Project we have **trained 2010** candidates and **placed 1704** rural candidates from U.P. and Uttarakhand.

❖ **Skill Development Training of NMDFC for Minority Community- 2400 candidates:**



“The goal of Training is Performance”.

National Minorities Development and Finance Corporation (NMDFC) was incorporated as a nonprofit company under Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India to provide concessional finance for self-employment activities to eligible beneficiaries belonging to the minority communities, having family income below poverty line.

We have implemented this scheme in 2013 in Ghaziabad, Meerut, Muzaffarnagar, Saharanpur, Badaun, Baghpat, Bulandshehar, Bijnor Districts of Uttar Pradesh state & Haridwar, Udham Singh Nagar Districts of Uttarakhand state. We have covered 10 Minority concentration Districts of Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand to implement this scheme and **Trained 2400** candidates and successfully **placed 1920** candidates.

❖ **Seekho Aur Kamao 2016-2017 (Ministry of Minority Affairs)-2000 candidates:**



Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India launched Seekho aur Kamao. The scheme aims at upgrading the skill of minority youth in various modern/traditional skills depending upon their

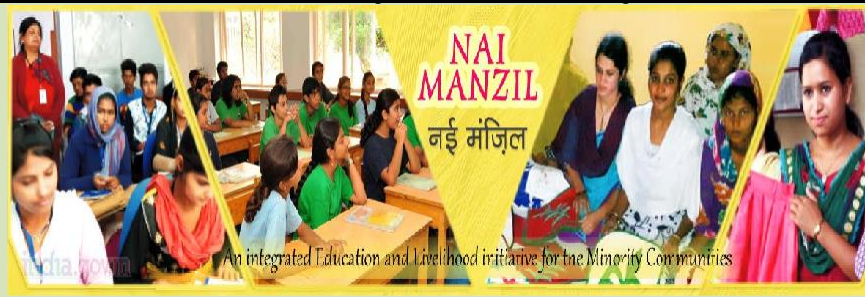
Qualification, present economic trends and market potential which can earn them suitable employment or make them suitably skilled to go for self-employment.

2000 Beneficiaries were allotted under this scheme. This scheme was implemented at 16 training centers (13 training centers in district Bulandsheshar ,Sambhal ,Moradabad ,Rampur ,Baghpat of Uttar Pradesh state & 3 centers in district Udham Singh Nagar of Uttrakhand state) and successfully placed **1607** candidates.

❖ Nai Manzil (Ministry of Minority Affairs)- 1940 candidates:



The Scheme aims to benefit the minority youths who do not have a formal school leaving certificate, i.e those in the category of school- dropouts or educated in community education institutions like Madarsas, in order to provide them formal education and skills, and enable them to seek better employment and livelihoods in the organized sector.

Under this scheme CRCCT trained 1940 candidates and prosperously placed 1534 candidates. This scheme was implemented in district Bulandsheshar, Sambhal, Moradabad, Rampur, Badaun, Sharanpur, G.B. Nagar, Meerut & Baghpat of Uttar Pradesh and Haridwar & Udham Singh Nagar of Uttarakhand .

❖ **Gharib Nawaj Skill Development Training Programme (Maulana Azad Education Foundation)- 2400 candidates:**



The MAEF has launched the new scheme titled Gharib Nawaz Employment Scheme from the current year 2017-18 so that short term job oriented skill development courses may be provided to minorities' youth in order to enable them for skill based employment.

We trained 2400 candidates under this scheme and successfully placed 1886 candidates in organized sector and self employment.

❖ **Seekho Aur Kamao-2018-19(Ministry of Minority Affairs)-650 candidates:**



Mission of this scheme is to improve the socio-economic conditions of the minority communities through affirmative action and inclusive development so that every citizen has equal opportunity to participate actively in building a vibrant nation.

In this scheme we have trained 650 candidates in **Aesthetic Dermatology Trainer job role** and placed 496 candidates. This scheme was implemented at 5 training center in district Ludhiana, Gurdaspur & Sangrur of Punjab state and district Haridwar of Uttarakhand state.

❖ **Ustad (Ministry of Minority Affairs) -90 candidates:**



The Ministry of Minority Affairs has launched a new scheme ‘Upgrading The Skills And Training In Traditional Arts/ Crafts For Development’ (USTTAD), which inter-alia, aims to preserve heritage of traditional arts and crafts of minorities and build capacity of traditional crafts persons and artisans. The scheme aims at capacity building and updating the traditional skills of master crafts persons and artisans.

This scheme was implemented at district Saharanpur of Uttar Pradesh state and trained 90 candidates in **Wood Crafting Trade**. We have placed all candidates in organized sector and self employment.

❖ **Seekho aur Kamao-407**



This scheme was launched by Maulana Azad Education Foundation (MAEF). We have trained 407 candidates in this scheme and more than 75 % beneficiaries were placed in the different organizations. This scheme was implemented in Haryana, Uttar Pradesh & Uttarakhand state.

❖ **Seekho aur Kamao- Vardhmaan Mahavir Open University, Kota, Rajasthan**



Maulana Azad Education Foundation (MAEF) has launched the Seekho aur Kamao scheme with Govt Organization/Universities to meet education and Skill development needs of marginalized sections of minority communities. This scheme was primary allocated to Vardhmaan Mahavir Open University, Kota, Rajasthan and we started this scheme after successful empanelment with the University. In this scheme we have trained 900 trainees in three districts Jaipur, Bhilwara and Tonk of Rajasthan state.

❖ **Seekho aur Kamao- JC Bose University of Science and Technology, YMCA , Faridabad, Haryana**



This scheme was allocated to CRCCT by JC Bose University of Science and Technology, YMCA ,Faridabad to meet education and Skill development needs of marginalized sections of minority communities. The scheme was aimed at upgrading the skills of the minority youth in various modern/ traditional vocations depending on their educational qualification, present economic trends and the market potential, which can earn them a suitable employment or make them suitably skilled to go for self-employment.

In this scheme we have trained 1300 trainees in district Ambala, Kurushetra, Panipat, Nuh, Gurgaon and Kaithal of Haryana state.

❖ **Skill Development Training Programme by Radico Khaitan Ltd, Rampur**

We have implemented this scheme at two training centers in district Rampur of Uttar Pradesh to provide skill development training for the job role Retail Management, Security Guard with Fire & Safety & Nursing Assistant (Bed Side Assistant). Total 120 candidates were allotted and we have successfully placed above 75 % candidates in organized sector.

❖ **Skill Development Project by THDC India Ltd.**

This program was launched by Sewa- THDC India Ltd for the rural youth in project affected area of THDC Khurja Super Thermal Power Project. The main objective of the programme was to develop the personality of rural students through improvement in communication, observation, computer and life skills. Total 95 beneficiaries were allotted under the programme. We have completed the programme with great outcomes.

❖ **Cow sanctuary in Uttar Pradesh for Stray Cattle:**



“Cow is the the source of Prosperous and progress .In many ways it is superior to one’s mother”

We established a first Cow Sanctuary in Kandauli and Komla Villages in Aligarh District of Uttar Pradesh and area of cow sanctuary is approx. 45.777 Hectare for ten thousand cows.

Now days many cows, calves and bulls are roaming on the road. When people see cows roaming on a road, they react by saying that the cattle owners should not let them loose and that they should be cared for and protected within the confines of a cowshed. Instead of finding their own food – often from trashcans and garbage heaps – they should be fed within the cowshed. Cattle are large and they need exercise. They need the sun and fresh grass and movement without which they fall sick very soon. That’s why we stand for the Cow Sanctuary for the caring of Cows.
